

STUDENT DRESS CODE

The following items are **not allowed**:

1. Sagging pants – SAGGING IS NOT ALLOWED
2. See-through garments (including autographed t-shirts), muscle shirts, tank tops, or halter tops
3. Midriff shirts or blouses which reveal skin when arms are raised above the head, reveal cleavage, or have straps less than 3 inches wide at the top of the shoulder
4. Pajamas, flannel, or lounge pants
5. Gym shorts (except during P.E class), or biker shorts
6. Skirts or shorts above the knee
7. Skirts, pants, or shorts with holes, tears with skin showing above the knee
8. Leggings (jeggings) are only allowed when worn with a skirt or top that meets the tips of the fingers when arms are held by the side in a relaxed position (mid-thigh)
9. Hooded jackets and sweatshirts will be allowed but hoods cannot be worn on the head
10. Hats, caps, or head gear on campus, including visors, bandannas, stocking caps, wrap caps, etc. (Items will be confiscated)
11. Sweat bands, wrist bands, sunglasses, rags, or items having no relation to school (Items will be confiscated)
12. Grooming instruments worn in hair (combs, brushes). Hair must not present a distraction.
13. Tattoos, markings, or writing on hands or other exposed body part that are offensive, immature or gang related.
14. House slippers (Shoes must be worn at all times)
15. Clothing judged indecent or inappropriate by the Administrators.

Articles of clothing, book bags, notebooks, personal items or physical body should be free of the following:

1. Symbols or words alluding to substances or activities illegal by law for minors: tobacco, alcohol, drugs, or gambling.
2. Gang symbols, signs, or language associated with gangs or gang activity
3. Profane, sexual, pornographic, violent, or suggestive language
4. Derogatory symbols, pictures, or language directed to any person or group
5. Fraternity and sorority emblems or references

All athletic uniforms or clothing associated with an extracurricular activity may be worn only on game day or for a school-related activity and must first be approved by administration.

Dress code violations are cumulative for one semester. The consequence ladder starts over at the beginning of each semester.

1st offense Warning and Parent Contact

2nd offense 1 day ISD

3rd offense 2 days ISD

4th offense 1 day OSS and parent must return with student for a conference

Subsequent offenses will receive 2 days Out-of-School Suspension and parent must return with student for a conference.

Any student found out of dress code compliance must change into appropriate dress prior to returning to class. Students who are unable to get into compliance must remain in ISD until appropriate dress is obtained.
